

#### **Richard Crossley Plans**

Richard Crossley has been building and flying free flight scale models for many years. He is probably best known for his indoor scale models, and in particular his lightweight competition models, with which he has won many National and International prizes. Richard is a graphic designer and illustrator by trade, working digitally on an Apple computer for a multitude of clients, but he also uses his graphic art skills to draw his model aircraft plans. Although digitally drawn, Richard endeavours to capture the style and character of pre-computer, hand-drawn plans that so many of us grew up with.

Richard's fully flight tested, mainly rubber powered designs show a wealth of detail on the plans, but essentially, they are relatively simple designs, being both lightweight and accurate. The plans are printed to order, and include photographic building instructions full of hints and tips, as well as the printed components laid out on 3" wide paper panels that can be spray-glued directly to your own selected balsa.

You can now buy a selection of Richard's plans direct from him on his newly launched website. As well as some old favourites, Richard has a number of exciting new scale plans nearing completion, and his latest release, a Polikarpov I-16 'Rata' to 1/14th scale looks very attractive indeed. I am aware that the Bowden contest is also being run and the scale contests may be run on the day that the Bowden in not being run, probably on Saturday. This will avoid any clash of contests and make the it possible for scale fliers to have a go in the Bowden.

#### Scale Rules for 2025

The Scale Rules for 2025 have now been agreed by the STC.

There are some fundamental changes in the way Free Flight classes have been organised.

To summarise:

The outdoor open classes have been amalgamated into one Superscale class.

The outdoor Flying Only class, now called Scale Free Flight, will now have a minimal preflight assessment for realism and craftsmanship.

A new provisional class, Assisted Free Flight, for radio assist and/or gyro guided "free Flight" models.

A new provisional indoor class. Flying only.

The Eddie Riding contests are now all to run to the FF2 Scale Free Flight rules.
